All the team are highly qualified and experienced in the care and education of young children and babies. With a life long commitment to learning and development. Teacher input via our Education consultant is given to all our children and staff.

Ratios

- 1 member of staff for every 3 children under 2 years old
- 1 member of staff for every 4 children aged 2 years old
- 1 member of staff for every 8 children aged 3 to 7 years old

We have a carpeted area for story time and sleep time. There are also lots of different areas for the children to play in, including the home corner, book corner, messy play, painting and lots more!

Records of Achievements

We would be grateful for input from parents to enhance these. Photos, certificates etc. Please feel free to browse the records and discuss them with your Key Worker. At the end of your child's nursery placement the record will go home with the child for you to keep.



Outdoors

Taking it account the physical developmental needs of toddlers, we have excellent safe and secure outdoor play facilities. This allows children to play out regularly in the fresh air with plenty of bikes, scooters, cars, balls and a large activity centre to enhance development.

Bluebells

The bluebell room cares for children aged 2—3 years. The ratio's for this age group is one adult to four children, which we meet at all times. The Bluebell Team plan's daily activities for the children to enjoy. The planning is done by carrying out developmental observations on each child and is undertaken with each child following the "Birth to three matters frame work." Within the Bluebell room the team promotes independent learning, social skills and personal development. Throughout a fun filled day your child will enjoy puzzles, singing, dancing, story telling , nursery rhymes and lots more.



Routines

The Bluebell room follows a daily routine. Toys and activities are planned around the children's needs, with specific activities planned to meet your child's individual needs. We also make outings to local places such as the library and park. This allows your child to visit other exciting places.

We have set meal times and sleep times. Your child will have an individual snuggle bed to sleep in. They will also have access to their comforts as they need them, such as a soft toy during quiet time and at sleep time.

Settling In

To help your child settle into the nursery, we encourage you to book in for some visits prior to their start date. This can be from half an hour up until three hours. This experience enables your child and yourself to develop a strong relationship with the team.

Please feel free to ring us throughout the day to speak to your child's key worker for an update on your child.

Meals

The children are provided with fresh and nutritious meals at nursery. The menu has a wide variety of nutritional food and is designed for growing children. We serve breakfast, lunch and tea and water is available throughout the day.



Key Worker Systems

- Every child has a designated carer called a key worker
- The key worker is responsible for the care and developmental needs of your child in nursery, along with the support of the Bluebell team.
- Your child's key worker will complete a daily diary for your child for you to share.
- If there is anything a parent wants to discuss it is preferential that this shall be discussed with the child's key worker.
